Hazel Wood presents a unique opportunity to own a captivating riverside broadleaf woodland nestled in the serene Cornish countryside.

Accessed from a quiet lane, the woodland boasts beautiful open rides leading throughout the site. A sea of Bluebells carpet every inch of the floor in season making it virtually impossible not to step on any when walking through the land. Wild garlic, primrose, fern and abundant fauna can also be found at lower levels.

Scattered throughout are inviting clearings, perfect for summer camping and woodland pursuits, while the gently flowing river offers serene spots for relaxation and even a refreshing dip in its shallow pools.

True to its name, hazel trees dominate the landscape, intermingled with birch, oak,

beech, hawthorn, ash, holly, and occasional sycamore. Notably, the woodland's western corner has been classified as ancient woodland.

Conveniently situated, Hazel Wood is within easy reach of the bustling market town of Liskeard, boasting a variety of amenities including shops, eateries, and services. Nearby attractions such as <u>Carnglaze Caverns</u> and the picturesque <u>Golitha Falls</u> provide ample opportunities for exploration. For the more adventurous, <u>Adrenalin Quarry</u> is a must.

For leisurely days by the sea, the charming coastal towns of Looe and Polperro are just a short drive away, offering sandy beaches and seaside delights.

Boundaries: The boundary is fenced to the east and south and borders farmland. The northern boundary is open and follows the stream and private woodland beyond. The western boundary borders neighbouring woodland and is marked with stakes painted grey.

Access: Vehicle access is possible via a wide track and shared gate. Parking is possible within the woodland.




